- (d) College/Institute must have an approved Principal/Director.

2) Best Principal/Director Award

- (a) Principal/Director must be permanently approved.
- (b) Principal/Director must have 5 years experience out of which 3 years experience must be in the institute/college affiliated to Pune University as Principal/ Director after getting the permanent approval.
- (c) (i) Ph.D. with at least one publication/research paper in referred/ peer reviewed journal **or**
 - (ii) Three research publications in referred/ peer reviewed journal.
- (d) Deans, members of Management Council, Senate & Academic Council are not eligible for the award (during tenure).

3) Best Teacher Award

- (a) Teacher must be permanently approved.
- (b) Teacher must have 10 years teaching experience after getting the approval.
- (c) (i) Ph.D. with at least one publication/research paper in referred/ peer reviewed journal **or**
 - (ii) Three publications in referred/ peer reviewed journal.
- (d) Age limit is upto 45 years for concerned teacher.
- (e) Deans, members of Management Council, Academic Council & Senate are not eligible for the award (during tenure).

4)Best Innovation in Teaching Award

- (a) Teacher must have 10 years teaching experience after getting the approval.
- (b) Teacher must have contributed to the development of innovative teaching methods in Colleges / University Departments / Institute.
- (c) Deans, Members of Management Council, Senate, and Academic Council are not eligible for the award (during tenure).

5) General Conditions

- (1) The College/Institute which has received Ist/IInd prize will be eligible to re apply after a period of 10 years. (Permanently affiliated). The Principal/Director/Teacher who has received Ist/IInd prize will not be eligible to reapply.
- (2) This scheme may be modified once in every 3 years.
- (3) It is not mandatory to give any award if any College/Institute, Principal/Director, Teacher, University Department, University Teacher is not found suitable.

The awards will be given on the Foundation Day of the University of Pune, every year.
