I am glad to have the opportunity to interact with everyone on the occasion of release of the **74th Annual Report** of Savitribai Phule Pune University. The last few years have been difficult due to the pandemic. Yet, we are continuing our prosocial work in these challenging circumstances, and bringing things back to normal. As a university, the biggest challenge we had was to smoothen the disrupted education process. The university and affiliated colleges are now faced with the new challenge of simultaneously adapting to the changes in education process due to Corona and implementing the New Education Policy. With this in view, the university has been constantly taking well-informed and inclusive decision, befitting the times.

We have so far proven that the objectives and policies of Savitribai Phule Pune University are determinate and specific. The various achievements of the university have been recognised and our unique identity has been imprinted globally. All our objectives and policies have always encompassed tradition, contemporary times and the future. The 75th year of the university shall mark the beginning of making them development-oriented. Thus, we shall work with the goal that this university, as a premiere educational and research institute, shall be actively competitive, socially aware and promoting conservation, innovation, expansion and development of knowledge, sustainable development and social welfare.

In the last year, we have focussed on skill-based courses, with employability, reestablishment and regularity of classroom teaching as our priorities. Thanks to the Choice Based Credit System, students have also got the opportunity to study in the fields of their choice. Policy has also drafted to make the courses and study material available on Swayam. As a solution to the dire problems unemployment generates, new syllabi have been implemented in collaboration with innovative businesses. Three vocational undergraduate courses have been started at the Skill Development Centre. This includes on-job training under the B.Voc. in Retail Management course, in collaboration with Maruti Suzuki. Many courses compatible with latest technology have been initiated, through Memorandums of Understanding (MOUs) with many companies and organisations. B.Sc. Blended, a four-year course, has been started, in collaboration with Melbourne University and students get the opportunity to spend two of the four years in Melbourne to complete the degree. Along with this, Start-up Innovation Cells have been inaugurated in many colleges, giving students the opportunity to take up innovative projects. The university has also started working on internationalisation of higher education, Academic Bank of Credits and the blueprint for four-year undergraduate degree courses.

The university has taken initiative in broader implementation of the New Education Policy, 2020, in colleges and the university, and undertook many relevant programmes in the last year. Informative lectures regarding the changes to happen in the methods of education were organised. The first innovative program to help parents, students and senate members interact was undertaken by Savitribai Phule Pune University, and it helped in allaying any doubts that parents had. Following the National Education Policy, 2020, the university is helping many educational institutes become autonomous and self-reliant. The university is also committed to technological development of its sub-centres, so that research and innovative initiatives can be empowered. Value education has been focussed upon to effectively implement National Education Policy and G-20 initiatives.

In its Diamond Jubilee year, Savitribai Phule Pune University has been at the forefront in drafting the National Education Policy plan and its widespread dissemination among all strata of society. Workshops and conferences about G-20 initiatives were organised in the university campus during this time. Savitribai Phule Pune University successfully carried out the constructive responsibility as a Higher Education Working Group Committee under G-20 Conference initiatives.

During the last year, the university has performed excellently in teaching and research on National and International level. In the **QS World University Rankings**, Savitribai Phule University has earned a position in the **'711 to 720' Group**. In the **World University Rankings** by Times Higher Education, the university has been placed in the **'600 to 800' Group**. In the **NIRF Rankings** by Ministry of Education, New Delhi, the university has stood **19th among all universities and 35th among all educational institutes**. In the Atal Ranking of Institutions of Innovation Achievements (ARIIA), Savitribai Phule Pune University has stood **First in the State and Eighth in the Country**. These achievements fill all of us with joy and pride.

Savitribai Phule Pune University has started five scholarships: Krantijyoti Savitribai Phule Financial Assistance Scheme, Lokshahir Annabhau Sathye Financial Assistance Scheme, Rajarshi Chhatrapati Shahu Maharaj Scholarship, Mahatma Jotirao Phule Meritorious Student Scholarship and Swami Vivekananda Student Assistance Scheme.

With the objective of swift administration, separate units for autonomous colleges and for the implementation of the New Education Policy have been established.

In this year, two meetings of the Advisory Council were held to discuss the New Education Policy, the programmes to be organised regarding the diamond jubilee of the university and to regarding measures to maintain high standards in global competition.

On the occasion of the diamond jubilee of Savitribai Phule Pune University, various programmes have been organised. The emblem for the diamond jubilee was recently unveiled by Hon. Chief Minister at the Mantralaya. Illustrious alumni were also felicitated as part of the diamond jubilee celebrations. The programme ***Jaagar Stree Shakticha*** was organised to honour women achievers in various fields. In continuation with the diamond jubilee celebrations, various programmes like publishing a special issue on the journey of the university so far, organising lectures in all the three districts under the university and organising poetry recital symposiums, among other programmes, are proposed.

Under the ***Azadi ka Amrit Mohotsav*** initiative, the ***Meri Maati Mera Desh*** missionis being implemented all over the country. As part of the mission, Savitribai Phule Pune University successfully implemented the ***Selfie with Maati*** initiative. Under the ***Meri Maati Mera Desh*** initiative, district-level cultural programmes like those in essay writing, street theatre, folk singing, folk music and mural painting were organised in the districts of Nashik, Ahmednagar and Pune. A one-day state-level conference on women empowerment was organised at the university jointly by Higher and Technical Education Department, Government of Maharashtra, and Savitribai Phule Pune University.

The university has taken in its stride the challenges thrown by circumstances from time to time. We have not seen them as 'difficulties', but as 'opportunities'. This has been possible because of the contribution and collaboration of professors, researchers, administrative officers, employees and students. In the future, higher education will see fundamental changes owing to the New Education Policy. The university sees this as an opportunity, and has planned its rigorous implementation and subsequent changes in work culture. We hope that the university will continue to carry out its social responsibility by raising a generation that is self-reliant and carries values that will help in nation-building.

2. 6. Educational Multimedia Research centre (EMMRC)

The Educational Multimedia Research Centre (EMMRC) was established in 1983 by the UGC with the aim of creating Educational Television Programmes for Higher Education. Over the years, EMMRC Pune has received more than 120 awards (International and National) for the best video programs, and the Centre has also produced various documentaries showcased in various festivals, earning recognition and prizes

During the pandemic, in addition to regular MOOCs delivery, EMMRC Pune trained University Faculty for delivering online lectures of their respective courses. The Centre also completed the Marathi translation project for 27 SWAYAM MOOCs courses (802 Modules).. From July 2022 to June 2023, the Centre produced 10 MOOCs (452 Modules) and 1 SWAYAM-Prabha video course (16 Modules). Seventeen courses produced by the Centre were offered on the SWAYAM online platform during this period. Under SWAYAM MOOCs, one Post Graduate course was developed by Mumbai University for EMMRC, Pune.

EMMRC, Pune, also developed a video course in 'BA Films, Television and New Media Production' for the SWAYAM-Prabha DTH Channel.

During the same period, the Centre covered (video recording) major activities of SPPU, including Independence Day, epublic Day, University Foundation Day, the implementation of NEP 2020, University Convocation, and many other activities. The Centre produced a half-hour video module for the Physical Education Department titled 'Yoga for Spondylosis' and three programs about the 'Caste Based Discrimination Committee' for the reservation cell of S P Pune University..

2.7. E-content Development & Learning Innovation Centre

The university has established a comprehensive 'e-content Development & Learning Innovation Centre' on the campus, equipped with modern facilities. Numerous e-content modules have been created, and digital classrooms have been set up to enhance the effectiveness of the teaching-learning process. The university boasts a fully functional state-of-the-art e-content

creation studio, enabling teachers to record their sessions using various IT tools in High Definition Video format. Faculty members extensively use modern technologies for lecture preparation. Live online broadcasts of sessions to students in affiliated colleges are facilitated, with a mechanism to receive queries through the website. The University has developed several 'Digital Classrooms' to ensure the effective and efficient delivery of lectures.

The university has launched a platform to deliver online courses in collaboration with globally renowned universities and faculty members. An MoU with Harvard Business School Online allows the University to offer courses at a special price for students and alumni. Best-in-class services from Amazon Web Services, Simplilearn, edX, Deakin University Australia, and some in-house developed courses are being offered to all students from the University, both on campus and in affiliated colleges, at concessional rates. The objective of this platform, known as 'Degree Plus,' is to make students employment-ready by pursuing these courses while completing their degree programs.

Furthermore, the university has collaborated with Pune Smart City (PCSCL) to offer programs under the 'Smart Training & Innovation Centre (STIC),' aligning itself with industry 4.0 in manufacturing and technology domains. The batches for these programs commenced in the first week of December.

The Universalization of Indian traditional knowledge system initiative, conducted by the Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR) in collaboration with the Government of India and SPPU, has resulted in the creation of knowledge capsules aimed at propagating Indian traditional knowledge to the global community. These capsules are offered as a certificate program.

The Learning Management System (LMS) developed by the University for teaching and examination conduction is extensively used by departments on campus and a few affiliated colleges, benefiting thousands of students and faculty members. The university initiated this activity to support colleges and campus departments, conducting capacity building for more than 2000 faculty members through e-CDLIC. A total of 2500 courses were mapped, and content was created for students to learn in an asynchronous mode.

2.8 Automation and e-Governance –

The University has a pervasive presence in three large districts of Maharashtra. As part of our consistent endeavors to maintain high academic quality and improve governance, the University has adopted various ICT-based process automations.

The process automation is focused on the Enhanced efficiency & effectiveness of processes, better accountability & responsiveness of services, ensuring inclusiveness & equity by ease of access, bringing in more transparency & participation in the system.

2.11 Skill Development Centre (SDC) :

The university boasts a fully functional Skill Development Centre offering multiple courses in the Skill Development space. Here are some of the key initiatives:

- 1) SD Courses on Moodle LMS for Extra Credits: E-Content developed for Financial Planning Skills, Programmable Logic Controller, Business Communication Skills, Web Designing and 5200 post-graduate students on SPPU Campus successfully completed the courses available on Moodle.
- 2) Short Term Professional Courses: Technical Writing: Industry Connect Activity with BMC Software, Techno writes, and Google India. Two batches of the course were conducted in the year 2022-2023. Solar PV System Installation: Industry Connect activity with Panama Group

Of Company, Clean Max Energy Enviro Solutions, Kalpa power, and Ztrik power India, PVT. LTD. This certificate course was conducted at QMTI for in-service soldiers from January 2023 to March 2023. Repair & Maintenance of Domestic Electronic Appliances: Industry Connections with Godrej & Boyce Mfg. Co. Ltd. This course was conducted for disabled soldiers at QMTI, Pune in the year 2022-2023.

- 3) Industry Academia Forum: The Industry Academia forum was inaugurated on August 20, 2022, to bring industry experts, academic faculty, and students together on a common platform for the exchange of knowledge and to extend support to students in terms of training and placement opportunities.
- 4) Bamboo Handicraft and Art Unit (BHAU): The SDC conducted a workshop on Weaving and Jewellery Design on April 26-27, 2022, and a one-day Lantern-Making workshop for students on September 24, 2022. The SDC and Science Park conducted a one-day Rakhee-Making workshop on July 2 & July 2022. The Centre organized a Bamboo Plantation drive in September 2022 on the occasion of World Bamboo Day.

Adobe, in collaboration with the SDC, conducted a faculty development program under the AICTE – MOU on August 17th, 18th, 22nd, and 23rd, 2022. SPPu was chosen by Adobe to conduct these training sessions. A total of 756 participants, consisting of faculty members from affiliated colleges under SPPU, were trained on Digital skills for Design and Creativity as part of an initiative by Adobe and AICTE. The program was coordinated by Dr. Pooja More of the SDC. All faculty members received certificates from AICTE and Adobe for their participation.

Additionally, 29 students pursuing B.voc in Retail Management have secured internships under an MOU with Maruti Suzuki India Limited. These students will receive a stipend of Rs. 9000 per month for the duration of the internship.

5.5 Jayakar Knowledge Resource Centre (JKRC)

The Jayakar Library is recently named as Jayakar Knowledge Resource Centre (as Per the Universities Act 2016). It is the central library and its activities recounted in this report demonstrate the commitment of Library staff to contributing to the fulfillment of SPPUs academic mission.

Withdrawals: The JKRC has written off a few books every year due to loss by users and the physical condition of the book that becomes irreparable and the condition becomes beyond use. Approximately 4500 to 5000 books have been written off so far, (170 during the year of the report) with the consent of the Knowledge Resource Committee.

Periodicals: The subscription of printed and electronic journals continued to receive preferences and recommendations from the Heads of the department. The total number of periodicals subscribed in the Knowledge Resource Centre is as below:




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




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


Districtwise Information of NBA Accreditation of Colleges, Institutes Aided Un-Aided)






Districtwise Information of NAAC Accreditation and Re-Accreditation of Colleges, Institutes (Aided Un-Aided)




Catagorywise Student Count in Recignized Institutes






Facultywise Student Count in Recignized Institutes








Catagorywise Student Count of Affiliated Colleges





