It gives me immense pleasure to connect with all of you through the 74th Annual Report of Savitribai Phule Pune University. As we celebrate the University's Platinum Jubilee year, significant transformations are taking place in the education sector across the country. Notably, the implementation of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 has commenced in universities and higher education institutions. During this transition, we have the opportunity to uphold our rich legacy while laying the foundation for a forward-thinking education system essential for a knowledge-driven society. This report provides a comprehensive overview of our University's diverse progress over the past year.

Our University is not only renowned nationally but also holds a distinguished position internationally. Since 2017, we have maintained an 'A+' grade in the NAAC rankings with the highest CGPA of 3.60 in the state. We continue to enhance our performance in various academic rankings. In 2023-24, based on excellence in teaching and research, we secured a position in the '711-720' band in the QS World University Rankings. In the Times Higher Education Asia Rankings, our university is placed in the '301-350' range, while in the overall Times Higher Education Rankings, we fall within the '801-1000' category. SPPU has been ranked at No. 3 position amongst all State Universities of the country in the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) by the Ministry of Education. Additionally, our university ranked 23rd among all universities and 37th among all educational institutions in India. Sustaining and enhancing quality in higher education requires continuous efforts, and we achieve this through the active participation of all stakeholders at the University.

Carrying the esteemed name of Dnyanjyoti Savitribai Phule, our University bears the responsibility of imparting modern, globally relevant knowledge and skills to students from all sections of society. We strive to empower those breaking free from ignorance and poverty with the strength to face new-world challenges. The implementation of NEP 2020 across various academic departments and the introduction of innovative curricula mark significant steps in this direction.

NEP 2020 emphasizes flexibility, allowing students to explore their interests while enhancing their diverse capabilities. It promotes interdisciplinary learning and integrates skill-based training essential for employment. In alignment with guidelines from the University Grants Commission (UGC) and the state government, our University has effectively initiated four-year undergraduate programs, one- and two-year postgraduate programs, and short-term credit-based courses. These courses cover a wide spectrum, from cutting-edge fields like Artificial Intelligence, Data Science, Internet of Things, and Cloud Computing to unique programs like MSc (Environmental Science) for forest rangers, MA (Digital Humanities), and BVoC (Supply Chain & Logistics). Additionally, we have introduced courses on drone technology for agriculture and disaster management, aerial photography, and even PhD research opportunities on the thoughts of Bharat Ratna Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar—an initiative of great significance as we approach the 75th anniversary of the Indian Constitution.

NEP 2020 also encourages collaboration between educational institutions, government bodies, and industries. In this regard, our university has signed agreements with Maharashtra's Forest Department, the India Meteorological Department, Agharkar Research Institute, Sarathi, as well as corporate entities like Praj Industries, Sancheti Institute, and Dr. Abhay Bang's 'SEARCH' in Gadchiroli. Furthermore, we have established academic collaborations with one university in Norway and two universities in Russia, strengthening partnerships between academia and industry.

On-the-job training and internships play a crucial role in skill development under NEP 2020. To facilitate this, we are actively forming partnerships with small and large industries and businesses relevant to various academic departments, ultimately increasing employment opportunities for students.

Recognizing the importance of effective implementation, our University is conducting training programs for faculty and administrative staff at multiple levels. A dedicated unit has also been established to oversee and coordinate all aspects of NEP 2020 execution.

Ensuring that no student discontinues their education due to financial constraints is a priority for our University. We facilitate various scholarship schemes for meritorious and underprivileged students, including the Krantijyoti Savitribai Phule Financial Assistance Scheme, Lokshahir Anna Bhau Sathe Scholarship for Students from Economically Weaker Sections, Rajarshi Chhatrapati Shahu Maharaj Scholarship, and the Swami Vivekananda Assistance Scheme for students from disaster-affected regions. The funds are directly deposited into students' bank accounts. Additionally, postdoctoral research fellowships and the prestigious D. K. Bhawe Scholarship for engineering students pursuing postgraduate studies abroad are also awarded. While the financial value of these initiatives exceeds ₹11.05 crores, their impact on nurturing academic talent is priceless.

Beyond academics, our University actively promotes arts and sports. We successfully hosted inter-university hockey, kho-kho, and baseball tournaments for women, with support from affiliated colleges like Tikaram Jagannath College, Chandrashekhar Agashe Physical Education College and Tuljaram Chaturchand College. Our athletes also excelled at national and international events, securing two team gold medals and five individual gold medals at the Khelo India University Games in Guwahati. Notably, four of our rowing athletes represented India at the World University Games in the Netherlands, a remarkable achievement for our institution.

The Student Development Board and National Service Scheme (NSS) further strengthen our University's commitment to societal engagement. A significant highlight last year was our participation in the 'Meri Maati, Mera Desh' initiative, which involved collecting Amrit Kalash and organizing the innovative 'Selfie with Soil' campaign. With 10,42,538 uploaded photos, this initiative earned Savitribai Phule Pune University a Guinness World Record.

Teaching, research, academic outreach, promoting artistic and athletic excellence and the holistic development of our students define our University's mission. The message of "Dnyana Bano Karmasheela, Karma Jvan" (Let knowledge inspire action, and let action be guided by wisdom) is central to our vision. Challenges will always arise, but the innovative spirit of our faculty, staff, administrative officers and governing bodies ensures that we find new solutions. This annual report reflects only a glimpse of our collective achievements. As we review our progress, let us resolve to work with even greater dedication in the coming year.

SPPU is one of the largest and most prestigious universities in the world, with a student strength of over 7 lakhs. The university houses 48 academic departments under 4 academic streams, each of which has its separate infrastructures, running 215 academic programs.

1.1.1 Excellence

- **QS World University Rankings:** The QS World University Rankings has been the most popular and known program in the world for many years. In the QS World University Rankings 2024, SPPU has secured a rank between 711-720 among world-class educational institutions across the globe.
- **Times Higher Education Asia University Rankings:** Savitribai Phule Pune University has secured a position between 301-350 in the Time Higher Education Asia University Rankings.
- **The Higher Education World University Rankings:** In the Times Higher Education World University Rankings 2024, SPPU has been placed in the **'801 to 1000' Group**.
- **National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF):** Savitribai Phule Pune University is one of the most academically sound universities in India marching Global Ranking. As per the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) of Central Ministry of Education, SPPU is ranked at the 23rd position amongst universities in India, and at the 37th position among higher education institutes in the country. Among the public state universities in India, SPPU is at the 3rd position.
- **NAAC Accreditation:** Savitribai Phule Pune University is re-accredited (Third Cycle) with A+ Grade in March 2017 with a CGPA of 3.60 by NAAC. This is the highest CGPA achieved by any university in the state of Maharashtra before 2017.

2.6 Educational Multimedia Research Centre (EMMRC)

The Centre has produced **6 MOOCs (293 Modules) for SWAYAM Portal** and **6 Swayam-Prabha video courses (112 Modules)** from July 2023 to June 2024. **12 courses** produced by the Centre were offered on **SWAYAM online** platform during this period.

2.10 Skill Development Centre (SDC):

The University boasts a fully functional Skill Development Centre offering multiple courses. Here are some of the key initiatives:

- Savitribai Phule Pune University and Maxion Wheels shall launch B. Voc. in Manufacturing Technology (scholarship program with Diploma awarded after two years) for local underprivileged students. Skill Development Centre, Savitribai Phule Pune University and Maxion Wheels, a leading global wheel manufacturer for passenger cars, light trucks, buses, commercial trucks and trailers, in partnership with Iochpe Foundation from Brazil is bringing “Formare”, a well-established academic scholarship program to the region of Pune, India.
- The program aims to enhance the employability of underprivileged Indian youth in the region by connecting classroom learning with real-world workplace experiences. This will be achieved by combining University curriculum and theory and providing targeted professional and social skills training at Maxion Wheels’ facilities in the Pune area.
- Students will receive a comprehensive academic scholarship sponsored by Maxion Wheels. In addition to 100% tuition fee being reimbursed, they will also receive a uniform, transportation, meals and a monthly stipend.

Vijaya Deshmukh Internet Centre, which has a number of computer terminals with internet facility. An average of more than 12 users per day have visited the Centre in person and used the electronic databases and internet facilities.

Digital Library

Jayakar Knowledge Resource Centre has developed its own Digital Library of rare materials. Knowledge Resource Centre has a variety of collections of rare documents in the form of books, manuscripts, maps, photographs, letters of eminent persons etc. The aim of the project is to digitize documents of common interest and make them available through intranet and internet. The centre has digitized a few old documents also. Among them, 18 are old journals with multiple volumes and issues.

5.4 Shodhganga:

The Shodhganga project of UGC INFLIBNET is of the digitized theses. After entering into an MoU on 26th April 2011, till date more than 13,499 theses of the University have been digitized and uploaded on this site. This year, 795 theses (660 Online submitted + 135 after scanning) were uploaded. The Knowledge Resource Centre also promptly uploads the latest theses which have been awarded Ph.D. by the University.
