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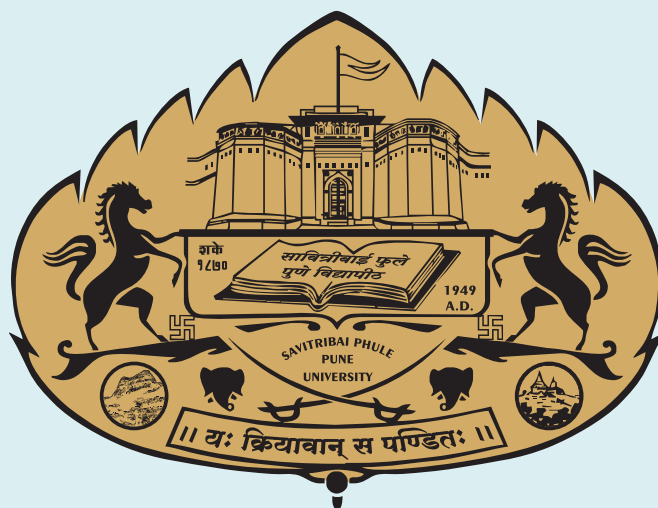

## *From The Vice-Chancellor's Desk...*

It gives me great pleasure to write this message for the 70<sup>th</sup> Annual Report of the Savitribai Phule Pune University (formerly University of Pune), a state university which is known for having the largest number of affiliated colleges and institutes.

The University believes in excellence, doing better than the best, striving to surpass the standards of expectation, facing challenges and limitations presented by the system. An academically conducive environment is provided to create 'Competent Global Citizens' in academia, professional world and beyond.

The University was ranked No 10 in the 'University Category', and at 17<sup>th</sup> position in the 'Overall Category' by the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) of MHRD. London based, Times Higher Education (THE) has positioned SPPU in 501-600 category in its World University Ranking, which is a significant advancement from its position in 600 to 800. SPPU is also proud to be listed at No 109 amongst the Asian Universities.

This year records a remarkable and unique achievement of the University — Its name was entered in the Guinness Book of World Records for planting the approximately 16000 trees in a day.

The University has introduced a B.Sc (Blended) degree program on campus in collaboration with University of Melbourne, Australia. A BA in Liberal Arts that involves multidisciplinary training in various subjects has been commenced. A master's degree program in Design was also started this year.

Affiliated colleges and Autonomous colleges are also contributed in the overall development of SPPU. Specially NSS, Students welfare are sports activities are well extended, Extra curricular, Co-curricular and Extension activities are implemented at large extension. In this report, these activities are included.

A unique scheme known as 'Assistance by SPPU for Project-based Initiative Research (ASPIRE)' was launched by the University to encourage research culture amongst young teachers. Projects will be funded by University after being scrutinized at two levels by scientist's national repute. This year also the University team participated at State Level in 'AVISHKAR', an innovation and research-based competition and won the second prize.

A SPPU Research Park Foundation was established to facilitate academia-industry interaction and promote entrepreneurial approach. This SPPU-RPF was inaugurated by Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi via video conference facility. Additionally, to strengthen research state-of-the-art instruments like Electron Microscopes, NMR are being added to the Central Instrumentation Facility of the University.

The University has hosted numerous national and international conferences in a various areas, for instance, the National Science Symposium with IUCAA and NCRA; Indian Anthropological Congress with Maharashtra Association of Anthropological Sciences etc. In addition, several MoU's have been signed to enhance industry orientation in research and to nurture start-ups.

The credit for these remarkable achievements goes to the entire SPPU family. The University believes in providing the best education at reasonable cost to all to 'enable learning', develop talent with skills where the strategic focus is not 'budget' driven but 'goal & performance' driven and the assets of the University are not merely good infrastructure but motivated academicians with exemplary character and unswerving integrity.

### *From The Pro-Vice-Chancellor's Desk...*

It gives me immense pleasure to write a message on the occasion of publication of 70<sup>th</sup> Annual Report of our University.

As the prestigious University in our country, our University has been tremendously consistent in all round performance. Presently 110 affiliated colleges have earned 'A' grade from NAAC, and 160 colleges have undergone NAAC assessment in the year 2018-19. The movement of autonomy has been gaining momentum. Currently 18 affiliated colleges have been conferred with autonomy by UGC and some of the proposals are in pipeline. It is worth noting that 49 institutions and 140 programmes have already been accredited by NBA. It would not be out of place to mention that during the current academic year following new programmes are introduced in tune with the requirements of industry and research organizations 1) BA (Liberal Arts), 2) B. Voc. (Retail Management), 3) B. Voc. (Supply Chain), 4) B.Sc. (Blended), 5) Master of Design, 6) M.Sc. (Astrophysics), 7) M.Sc. (Astrobiology), 8) M.Sc. (Urban Water and Sanitation), 9) BBA (Hospitality and Facilities Management), 10) BBA (International Business for International Students), 11) M.A. (Lifelong Studies), 12) M.A. (Yoga), 13) P.G. Diploma in Data Analytics in Economics)

In sink with prominent global practices in higher education, we have successfully introduced Choice Based Credit System for undergraduate programmes in affiliated colleges. For effective implementation, workshops were organized for the teachers of the affiliated colleges. In order to boost research culture on the campus, University has introduced SPPU-Post Doctorate Fellowship. 12 Scholars have been selected under the scheme in 2018-19. The University has received Rs. 100 Crore grant under RUSA Scheme from MHRD for undertaking cutting edge research and enhancement of infrastructure.

To build startup culture, innovation and incubation cells have been established in 240 affiliated colleges. Business idea competitions and investors meet were organized recently. The University has appointed Deans for all four faculties. Enrichment of human capital on the campus has been relentless assignment for the governance. Keeping this in view, training and workshops were organized for the officers and members of various authorities on contemporary themes. UGC has selected 9 colleges as the mentoring colleges for preparation of NAAC assessment of affiliated colleges. During the current academic year, 19 new colleges have been approved by the state government. The University has been contemplating to explore the research and academic opportunities in Jammu, Kashmir and Ladakh region.

Our University has exhibited outstanding performance consistently in 'AVISHKAR' research competition. Numerous outreach programmes have been organized by NSS particularly in water conservation, tree plantation, cleanliness campaign, etc.

All the endeavours have been proving instrumental in enhancing the status and ranking of the University in the spectrum of teaching-learning, research, innovation and extension.

Maharashtra and especially the Savitribai Phule Pune University (Formerly, University of Pune) have always been at the forefront of evolving new paradigms, which involve new thought processes. Savitribai Phule Pune University, one of the premier Universities in India, is located in the North-Western part of Pune city in picturesque green surrounding sprawling over 411 acres. The University is symbolically identified with the Main Building; it is a monumental building with a beautiful architecture, and was once the summer residence of the Governor of Bombay in the days of the British Raj. Built in 1864 architecturally, it defies classification through its spiritual antecedents and the 80 feet flag tower has been described as a 'Victorian rendering of an Italian campanile'.

The University is one of the largest and prestigious Universities in the world with students' strength of over 7.5 lakh. The university houses 49 academic departments under 04 academic streams and each of which has its own separate buildings running 194 academic programs. The University has 716 affiliated colleges, 174 recognized management institutions, 75 research institutes of National repute. There are 09 Autonomous colleges and 11 colleges are recognized by UGC as "Colleges with Potential for Excellence (CPE)" and 1 college as College with Excellence.

The University has on campus in-house capacity to provide accommodation to 3719 male and female students with separate residential facilities for international students, teachers and staff. The University runs a chain of refectory, hostel mess and canteens on the campus.

**Governance & Best Practices** –The University has nurtured a vision consistent with its rich traditions and followed a new path of development. The principal focus of the University has been to facilitate learning and scholarship all the way up to the current frontiers of knowledge, research that pushes the frontiers of knowledge, technology at the cutting edge, and innovations to address problems and opportunities in industry/society and entrepreneurship that generates wealth in the society.

**Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)** –The University and its around 790 Affiliated Colleges/Recognized Institutes successfully uploaded the department's data on All India Survey on Higher Education (A.I.S.H.E.) web portal in the year 2018-2019.

1. Management Information System (MIS) – As per the directives of Government of Maharashtra and Directorate of Higher Education, the IQAC cell has collected online information from affiliated Arts, Commerce, Science, Law, Education, Physical Education colleges and from the institution conducting non-professional courses.
2. Uploaded 100% information of MIS of all the University departments and all affiliated

colleges. Facility of issuing online “No objection certificate” MIS and AISHE is introduced. Due to this facility, the University has saved human efforts, Paper Printing, etc.

### **Assistance by SPPU for project based innovative research (ASPIRE)**

- a. From the academic year 2018-19, after redesigning the guidelines of the research program, the scheme was renamed from BCUD Research Project to ASPIRE.
- b. There are following two schemes under ASPIRE for researchers.
  1. Research Mentorship programme.

Under this programme, financial assistance given to the university approved teachers, below the age of 35, for the purpose of research. Rs.3 Lakh will be sanctioned to the faculties under Science & Technology and Rs.2 Lakh to other faculties.

2. Impact oriented Research programme.

Under this programme, financial assistance given to the university approved teachers, above the age of 35 but below the age of 57, for the purpose of impact oriented research. Rs.15 Lakh will be sanctioned to the Science, Engineering, Pharmacy and Rs.6 Lakh to other disciplines based on realistic requirements of the proposal.

3. Under the Research Mentorship programme total 863 research proposals have been received and approximately an amount of Rs. 3,25,00,000/- sanctioned to the eligible proposals. Similarly, 552 research proposals were received from the researcher under the Impact oriented Research programme.

### **National Assessment and Accreditation Council, Bengaluru and Ministry of Human Resource Development, New Delhi.**

- a) Out of 364 Affiliated Colleges/Recognized Institutes 309 are having NAAC valid accreditation status.
- b) 49 Affiliated Colleges/Recognized Institutes’ accredited and re-accredited 142 Under-Graduate and Postgraduate programmes in the Academic Year 2018-19 by National Board of Accreditation, New Delhi.

### **Awards and recognitions –**

- A) The University has been ranked at number 10<sup>th</sup> position in University category and 17<sup>th</sup> position in Overall category by M.H.R.D. 's National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) for the Year 2019.

In the last three years the University has been constantly Ranked by N.I.R.F. in the first 10 top Higher Education Institutes.

- B) According to the survey conducted in the year 2018 by Times Higher Education World Ranking, the University has been ranked between 500-600.

### **Avishkar State level Research Competition**

13<sup>th</sup> Maharashtra State Inter university research Convention ‘AVISHKAR - 2018’ was organized by the Gondwana University, Gadchiroli during 15<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup> January, 2019 at Gadchiroli. Total 48 students from 6 streams participated in this competition programme. (UG, PG, PPG & Teacher categories)

University has secured the first prize under U.G., P.G. and Teacher Category of the following faculties.

1. Commerce, Management and Law (P.G and Teacher Category)

2. Agriculture and Animal Husbandry (P.G and Teacher Category)
3. Engineering and Technology (U.G. and Teacher Category)

Subsequently, the second prize secured by the faculties under Humanities, Arts, Fine Arts (Teacher Category) and Agriculture and Animal Husbandry (U.G. Category).

From the overall above performance the University team got runnership in Avishkar State level Research Competition.

#### **Anveshan Research Competition:**

- a. Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi, organizes conventions every year in five zones. In the last year, "Anveshan 2018 West Zone Competition" was held at Pacific Academy of Higher Education and Research University, Udaipur. Five girls (Savitrichya Leki) From Savitribai Phule Pune University had participated in all categories under five streams and Miss. Shubhada Padwal was awarded a gold medal under the category of Engineering & Technology.
- b. The winner of the West Zone participated in the next stage of "Anveshan National Level Research Competition" which was held at Ganpat University, Maihsana (Gujrat).

**Jaykar Knowledge Resource Centre** – The Central Jayakar Library is one of the best centres of reference and information in the entire country. The library subscribes to Indian and foreign research journals, and also receives periodicals on gratis and exchange basis. It has more than 525134 books and Journals on varied subjects. Inter-library loan facility is extended to many colleges, institutions and government agencies. The Jayakar Library has preserved a wealth of ancient Indian texts in the form of manuscripts and books. It is one of the best centres of reference and information in the country. The Library is named as Jaykar Knowledge Resource Centre to pay tribute to Barrister M. R. Jayakar, the Founder Vice-Chancellor of the University.

#### **The Library has :**

- ❖ Various reference sources including encyclopedia, dictionaries, yearbooks, biographies, gazetteers, etc.
- ❖ 6000 + e-books on perpetual basis
- ❖ Subscription to eminent international databases
- ❖ More than 39 online database and journals
- ❖ Over 4000 manuscripts of quality literary works written in Hindi, Sanskrit and Marathi
- ❖ Music Library of rare and old musical collection

**International Centre (IC)** – The University has emerged as a favoured destination for International Students from across the globe. The International Centre acts as a Coordination agency between the students, the various Departmental Heads, and the Heads of Colleges and Institutions, affiliated to the University as well as the Heads of Chancery, Embassies, Consulates, their educational counsellors and their educational wings.

**(ELICIS)** - The International Centre conducts English Language Intensive Course for International (ELICIS) for international students. This course is a foundation course to prepare foreign students to study at the college and university level. It prepares the students for the Indian system of education where emphasis is more on writing and helps them to adjust to the Indian environment.

**Hostel for International Students** - The International Centre maintains two international hostels: one for boys and one for girls, conveniently located within the campus. The International Boys

Hostel (IBH) has 96 rooms, while the International Transit House (ITH) International Girls' Hostel, has 42 rooms that provide accommodation for girls. There are six 1 BHK flats available in the girls' hostel and 9 kitchens. To accommodate international delegates, six 2 BHK flats with a kitchen are available

The University is a symbol of international integration as the number of foreign students is studying around 501 students from 53 countries.

**Excellence**

SPPU has secured 4<sup>th</sup> Rank amongst State Universities in India for Graded Autonomy granted by the UGC. (Category I). In a historic decision for the Indian higher education, SPPU

is the only State University selected amongst higher educational institutions of India, which have maintained high standards of excellence and have been granted graded autonomy by the UGC.

**University National Ranking**– The Savitribai Phule Pune University is one of the most academically sound universities in India marching towards Global Ranking. As per MHRD's National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) our University is Ranked at 10<sup>th</sup> Position. Ours is the only University in Maharashtra to achieve this status and is one of the Top five state Universities in the country.

**NAAC Accreditation** – The Savitribai Phule Pune University was re-accredited (Third Cycle) with A+ Grade in March 2017 with a CGPA of 3.60 by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) an autonomous institution of the University Grants Commission. This is the highest CGPA achieved by any University in the state of Maharashtra.

**University with Potential for Excellence (UPE)** – Our University has been recognized by University Grants Commission as University with potential for Excellence. Through the funding received under this scheme the university has introduced modern ICT based methods of teaching and learning, evaluation methods for achieving excellence in teaching and research.

**Performing University** – The University has been recognized as the Performing University in “A” Category for Value added research and development by Department of Science and Technology (DST) of Government of India continuously for two phases under its “Promotion of University Research and Scientific Excellence (PURSE) Programme.”

**Leading State University Going Global**-The Savitribai Phule Pune University (SPPU) has earned a place of distinction at the UK - based Times Higher Education World Ranking 2016-17, where it has been placed between 601 and 800 among universities worldwide. Times Higher Education [THE] World University Rankings 2017 has ranked SPPU at a joint 2<sup>nd</sup> position among the conventional Indian Universities.

SPPU became the first Indian university to be a member of the International Ballistics Society

(IBS) with an aim to improve and promote the Science of Ballistics. Earlier the Defence Research and Development Organization (DRDO) was the only Indian member of the IBS.



### **Collaborations**

- ❖ The University has signed various memorandums of understanding [MoUs] with international universities from Asia, Europe, Australia and America. As a part of this programme, we are now associated with UNESCO IHE Delft, The Netherlands, and Unity Knowledge LLP, Pune India for water education, training and capacity building. The University aims to develop a Fire Training Module with the help of WuFeng University.

A MoU has been signed to set up a rooftop plant of 600KW on 14 of its buildings, which is a step forward put by SPPU to make the university campus eco-friendly with the help and support from PSCDCL.

## COMMUNITY CONNECT

In order to impart science learning to school children and citizens, Savitribai Phule Pune University has redesigned its 'Science Park', which is now located at the Department of Environmental Science. This Science Park at the SPPU will have a 'Speaking Tree' that will narrate the stories of all birds, animals and insects living on it.

- ❖ Researchers at Savitribai Phule Pune University's Science Park have developed a method to recycle and reuse plaster of paris [PoP] such that reusable powder can be recovered from the PoP waste. The team of scientists recovered the PoP used to make Ganapati idols, sculptures and moulds, and interior decorations.
- ❖ 'Heritage Walk', a guided tour through the historical campus of SPPU was initiated in February 2018. The objective is to make people familiar with the architectural grandeur and history of Pune University. It includes a walk through the buildings, Museums, flora and fauna on the campus. The underground 300 feet tunnel of a university built in the 1860s was made open to the public during this guided tour. Heritage objects like historical arms, amethyst and rhinestones, ancient coins, statues are placed in the museum.

- ❖ In order to give senior citizens a platform to express themselves, Savitribai Phule Pune University (SPPU) has organized a 'Literature festival' for senior citizens in the city. The festival has been organized in association with Association of Senior Citizens Organization, Pune (ASCOP).
- ❖ “Mission Young and Fit India” was launched by Bharatratna Sachin Tendulkar at Savitribai Phule Pune University on 21<sup>st</sup> May 2018. The aim of this mission is to create awareness about sports, not just for the students participating in sports but each student studying in the university or any of its affiliated colleges. Principals and Physical Directors of affiliated colleges interacted with Bharatratna Sachin Tendulkar and he passed on a message that this Mission should be executed in their colleges with high priority.
- ❖ Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri. Narendra Modi's address to students on 'Reducing the Stress of Examinations' was broadcasted by SPPU through digital mode and through Vidyawani, SPPU's own Community Radio.

## Chapter 2

### UNIVERSITY : NEW DIRECTIONS & POLICIES

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Improving the quality of higher education requires expansion, inclusion and excellence. The Savitribai Phule Pune University has taken many initiatives to nurture education and research activities, which are necessary for the benefit of society and industry.

#### **Research:**

Research is the focus area for the University and numerous initiatives have been taken by the University to promote and enhance research in the University.

**Development of Research Publication Portal** – The Research Publication Portal is developed to showcase the research done by the faculty at international-level during last year there has been a tremendous growth in publication of research articles at the International Level. The numbers of research publications have gone up to 5649 in the year 2018-19 from 1569 in the year 2011-12. This has increased the h-index of the University from 40 in 2011-12 to 113

The university has adopted a unique practice of appointing eminent academicians as ‘**Distinguished Professors**’ to inculcate scientific vigor and discipline amongst the budding investigators.

The University provides seed research funding from its own funds to the teachers on campus and in affiliated colleges/recognized institutes to explore research ideas leading to larger proposals for generating funding from various agencies. To maintain high quality research output, the University organizes ‘Research Project Competition’ at different places under the university jurisdiction. A large number of students participate in these competitions. The selected projects/papers are presented in the ‘Avishkar’- A State Level Research Competition’ held annually at different Universities.

The University has established SPPU Research park foundation –section 8 company to promote partnerships with Research establishments, R&D Centres of Industry and promote scalable research through joint efforts of stakeholders, University and RPF. This has been supported by Rashtriya Uchchar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) and is being mentored by the University of California, Irvine. It is envisaged that through this centre, a strong research foundation will be created for commercial and usable research. It would also incubate startups qualified by the Centre for Innovation, Incubation and Enterprise meeting the criteria set by RPF. This is guided by a strong industry Board.

**Centre for Innovation, Incubation & Enterprise (CIIE)**- University has established Centre for

Innovation, Incubation & Enterprise and is instrumental in developing startups, promoting entrepreneurship, focused efforts to enhance the quality of research through Patents, IPR and developing national and international linkages. CIIE has established a startup policy that includes faculty's role in startups, entrepreneurship development through University departments and affiliated college systems. CIIE has established an incubation centre that has 11 startup companies working which are granted support of office infrastructure, mentorship and customised programs to nurture the startups. In the second cohort, a total of twelve startup companies have been shortlisted by the centre.

Areas have been identified for the incubation:

1. Electric Mobility
2. Water & Waste Management
3. Agriculture Technology
4. Healthcare
5. Material Science
6. IT

Incubatee company Nuinance Phytovigyan was winner for ISET Singapore 2020, Winner DCF Venture in startup category -2019, Invitee for Nano Korea 2018.

Ideas incubated and nurtured by CIIE are then sent to SPPU research park foundation which is a section 8 company

Initiation of Startup Innovation cells at affiliated colleges has led to creation of 234 cells in colleges in Pune, Pune rural, Nasik and Ahmednagar. To promote culture of original thinking, ideation competitions were conducted and 2000+ ideas were showcased through 13 clusters created at different colleges. Twenty student startup teams have been identified for virtual incubation under the centre. Regular boot camps, master classes, conferences, investor meets, hackathons are conducted by the Indian Government. To promote patents, a showcasing platform has been developed by the centre for departments and affiliated colleges. CIIE has received a grant from Maharashtra State Innovation Society (MsiNS) for establishment of an incubation centre and seed funds to the startups. CIIE has engaged with multiple stakeholders through Memorandum of Understanding namely Pune Smart City Corporation, The Indus Entrepreneurs (TiE), KPIT and works closely with incubation centres like Venture Centre, SINE, DISQ, IIM-C Innovation park to name a few. Focused efforts to promote social entrepreneurship, women entrepreneurs have been undertaken by the centre. International engagements by the centre has led to French Embassy proposing the next Knowledge Summit of 2021 at SPPU that would have 100 plus French researchers and delegates at the University. The centre has established online courses for the benefit of students at a very nominal cost and in the launch month had 500 participants undertaking the course. The centre is governed by three boards: Board of Innovation & Incubation, Board of Research and Board of National & International linkage with industry leaders and other eminent professionals. Centre has recently established an investor committee that works on bringing the investor community to the centre through a structured effort to provide the required support to the funding process.

#### **SPPU Research Park Foundation (RPF):**

SPPU Research Park Foundation (SPPU-RPF) is a section 8 company fully owned by Savitribai Phule Pune University (SPPU). Research Park has been set up to facilitate and assist entrepreneurs directly and indirectly with infrastructure support, laboratory space, special instrument and equipment facilities in certain areas, know-how and technical support, information support,



business mentoring support, administration and market support, provide avenues for researchers and technologists for taking laboratory research in various academic and research institutions. SPPU-RPF's objective is to bring the MSME industry for co-location, conduct entrepreneurship training, incubate startups, conduct Industry –academia meets for the benefit of students and faculty, attract leading industries to establish R&D centers in SPPU and start generating revenue towards self-sufficiency.

Established in January 2019, it is promoting research-based entrepreneurship, offering incubation space for start-ups as well as providing co-location facility to industry for Research and Development. It is a 'gateway' to take SPPU research to industry and society at large.

SPPU-RPF invited incubation applications during the January 2019 to December 2020 period. Of these, two (bioplastic and electric mobility) are incubated and reached the investment stage. Team working on bioplastic (WeWakeIndigreen Pvt. Ltd) has been approved 5 lakh grant by the SPPU board for their market and product research. This company has also been shortlisted among top 10 start-ups by Govt. of India. SPPU-RPF and SPPU has signed an LoI with Australian Institute of Water Science India for wastewater management training, consultancy and projects in the month of December 2019. SPPU-RPF is actively promoting SPPU facilities.

**Design Innovation Centre - Design Innovation Centre** has been initiated and funded by the **Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD)** under the scheme “**National Initiative for setting up of Design Innovation Centres, Open Design Innovation Centre** - The Design Innovation Centre (DIC) has been created to establish a network with the, industries, end users, farmers etc. so as to understand their problems and provide solutions. It serves as a link between Savitribai Phule Pune University Faculty, spoke centres and Industry partners. The DIC serves as a consortium of research faculty, students on the campus and at the spoke centres. Thus, with the active participation of University faculty and Spoke centres, various innovative ideas are being envisioned and executed leading to the development of a number of prototypes for the end-users and similarly generate funds for the sustenance and continuation of DIC activities.

**Best Practices and Innovations** - The University has explored innovative and creative ways to design and implement strategies for achieving excellence in teaching and research. Following are some of the innovative practices which delivered significant results in the classrooms and research laboratories, in global outreach and community connect, in fulfilling aspirations of all the stakeholders and in contributing to national development.

### **Educational Multimedia Research centre (EMRC)**

Educational Multimedia Research Centre, SavitribaiPhule Pune University, was established in 1984 by the University Grants Commission to impart Educational Television Programmes for Higher Education. Later on, as the technology grew and the need for changes was the requirement of the hour, since 2012, the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, took an initiative, under the NME-ICT Project, in developing syllabus based e-Content programmes for 89 under-graduate students. In 2017, again the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, took an initiative in developing Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs) for all levels from school to higher education. This Centre was given the task of developing MOOCs Courses for under-graduate subjects. In June 2019, the Centre was also given the task of developing the post-graduate Courses.

Under this, the Ministry developed the SWAYAM Portal. “Study Webs of Active-Learning for Young Aspiring Minds” (SWAYAM) is the indigenous ICT based platform for hosting Massive Open Online Courses(MOOCs) developed under the aegis of NME-ICT. An initiative of Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Government of India, MOOCs supplement the formal education system in the country from high school to higher education offering courses based on curriculum, continuing education and skill. Since 2017, the Centre has developed about twenty-three under-graduate MOOCs Courses.

Till date, the Centre has offered a total of Twenty-Four UG Courses to students from June 2018 Semester.

### **E-content Development & Learning Innovation Centre-**

The university has developed a full-fledged modern ‘e-content Development & Learning Innovation Centre’ on campus. The university has also created many e-content modules and established digital classrooms for an effective teaching learning process. University has a fully functional state-of-the-art e-content creation studio which facilitates teachers to record their sessions using various IT tools in High Definition Video format. Modern technologies are extensively used by University faculties for lecture preparation. Sessions can be broadcasted live online to students of affiliated colleges with mechanism to receive queries through website. The University has developed several ‘Digital Classrooms’ for effective and efficient delivery of lectures.

**Automation and e-Governance** – The University has a pervasive presence in three large districts of Maharashtra. As a part of our consistent endeavours to maintain high academic quality and improve governance, the University has adopted various ICT based process automations.

Process automation focused on:

- Enhanced efficiency & effectiveness of processes
- Better accountability & responsiveness of services
- Ensuring inclusiveness & equity by ease of access bringing in more transparency & participation in the system.

## **Global Initiatives of Academic Networks (GIAN)**

The University actively participates in Global Initiatives of Academic Networks (GIAN) a UGC initiative, tapping the talent pool of academicians, scientists and entrepreneurs internationally. The aim is to encourage their engagement with the institutes of Higher Education in India so as to augment the country's existing academic resources, accelerate the pace of quality reform and elevate India's scientific and technological capacity to global excellence.

**Curricular Aspects** – The Curricula of UG and PG courses are revised regularly. The University has introduced a Choice Based Credit System (CBCS). There are three mandatory prime components namely core components, inter-disciplinary components and Vocational Components/Skill components.

**Enrichment Courses** – University has initiated a special guidance programme in soft skills for students from Tribal areas. Through this support, a tremendous change has been noticed in the students from rural as well as urban colleges, with respect to communication skills and personality development.

The colleges are given flexibility to organize a large number of special guidance camps on soft skill programmes.

## **Fellowships-**

The University has made a provision to provide fellowship to all the students registered for M.Phil. and Ph.D. working in University departments, Affiliated colleges and recognized institutes.

POSCO Asia Fellowships are provided to promising students of Savitribai Phule Pune University pursuing their Master Course in the field of Humanities and Social Sciences.

## **Scholarships**

The D.K. Bhave Scholarship is provided to students pursuing Master's Degree courses in Engineering Faculty at accredited Universities in USA, Canada, United Kingdom, Germany.

Provision to make online applications and payments along with door-delivery of the documents ensures student-friendly delivery of essential services.

### **Skill Development Centre**

Skill Development Centre at Savitribai Phule Pune University was established in March 2014 with an objective to eliminate disconnect between academics and the reality in the global job market. The Centre has introduced three year B.Voc. Degree programmes, which are well focused on training undergraduate and postgraduate students of University in various employable skills so as to enhance their employability. Rigorous training is given to students in communication skills, values and professional ethics to enable them to venture out with confidence and prove their calibre in the competitive workplace.

Nine colleges affiliated with Savitribai Phule Pune University have also been identified by UGC to introduce B.Voc. programs apart from these 10 colleges have received grants under 'Community Colleges' Scheme of UGC.

2.	<b>Mediclaim Policy:</b> The Group Mediclaim and Group Accident policy scheme is being implemented for University Teaching and Non-Teaching employees (Government Approved, University Fund and Self-Supporting Departments, Statutory posts, Teaching & Non Teaching Staff on contractual basis and on regular pay scale) The Mediclaim policy of the year 2018-19 is of Floater type. 1404 university employees and 3500 relatives of the university employees are covered under this scheme. The sum insured under this scheme is Rs. 3 lakh for employees and family members. University teaching and non-teaching employees serving on Government sanctioned posts, University funded posts and confirmed employees who are serving for the period of more than 20 years in self-supporting Departments, Statutory posts and Teaching & Non Teaching Staff on contractual basis and on regular pay scale are eligible for this scheme. University has shouldered 100% financial responsibility of the premium for the employees and in case of relative's 50% premium of the insurance policy shall be paid by the University and 50% premium shall be deducted from the employees' salary.

- ❖ Savitribai Phule Pune University has received a whopping Rs.100 Crore grant from the Union Government under the Rashtriya Uchchastar Shikshan Abhiyan (RUSA) for its consistent performance in the field of research and its high ranking on the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) and National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF).
- ❖ The UGC's Human Resource Development Centre at SPPU has been identified as one of the National Resource Centers (NRCs) by the MHRD for conducting online refresher programmes for faculty through SWAYAM in the subject area 'Leadership and governance in Higher Education'. For this National Resource Centre, MHRD will be providing financial assistance of Rs. 22.50 lakh for each programme. The Centre will provide online service education to teachers of colleges and universities in the area of 'Leadership and Governance in Higher Education'.
- ❖ The Norwegian Centre for International Co-operation in Education approved the International Joint Project on "Teacher Education" to the University College of SouthEast Norway and Department of Education & Extension of SPPU. Under this project a grant of Rs. 1.65 Crore is approved by the Norwegian Government.

### CENTRAL FACILITIES

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#### Central Instrumentation Facility:

The Central Instrumentation Facility (CIF) at Savitribai Phule Pune University (SPPU) has been established as a backbone facility for academicians and researchers from the campus and affiliated colleges, in the high priority areas of research in basic sciences. In tune with the global scenario, emerging interdisciplinary research merging Chemical, Life, Physical, and Earth sciences demands state of the art sophisticated instrumentation support in order to work out high quality and meaningful work. Such type of CIF is a novel and unique facility in State universities in Maharashtra. This facility is being extended to all the universities, academic institutes, national research institutes, defense institutes, and industries in India.

## **Student's Health Service Scheme**

### **1) Medical examination of the Students at College level:-**

Under Student's Health Services Scheme, Health check-up of all First Year students of Senior Colleges & Hostel Residents under jurisdiction of Savitribai Phule Pune University is compulsory.

### **2) Specialists Services at Students Health Service Scheme office:-**

The Students needing Specialists consultation are referred to the Specialists Centre at University campus.

Students, employees, and foreign students availed the benefit of the Specialists services.

#### **a) EMS: - O.P.D. attendance at University Health Centre Ruby Hall Clinic**

#### **Aims and Objectives:**

Provide first-aid, resuscitate, stabilize and shift the patient at the earliest to a tertiary care hospital for further management, as per the patient's or his relative's or discharge the patient, depending on the severity of symptoms.

- a. EMS Centre has been established at SPPU
- b. It is well equipped with state of the art instruments and equipment like Multipara-Monitor, Pulse Oximeter, and Transport Ventilator are available.
- c. There is a clean and modern infrastructure.
- d. Emergency services are provided round the clock (24/7)
- e. There is an equipped ambulance permanently stationed at the premises of the EMS Centre for picking up and transferring the patient.
- f. The day to day running of the Emergency Services is managed by Ruby Hall Clinic, Pune. It is one of the oldest and a premier hospital setup in Pune.

#### **b) Dental Services**

Aims and Objectives: To Provide Dental services, such as consultation, extraction, scaling, root canal, dental cap / crown, etc, at the Health Centre of SPPU

- g. Dental services is provided for 8 hours a day on all working days of SPPU,
- h. Dental Services are provided at a very low cost.
- i. The day to day running of the Dental Services is managed by Dental College, DPU, Pune.

### **3) Medical Examination of University Hostel Students and International Students:-**

Medical Examination of 624 University Post-Graduate Hostel students, 281 International Students were undertaken at Student's Health Services.

### **4) SPECIAL FEATURES:-**

#### **i) Yoga Education Centre:-**

Yoga Education Centre was started w.e.f. March 2002 in collaboration with Shriram Madhava Yoga Samiti Kaivalyadham, Lonavla U.G.C. has sanctioned a grant for the Yoga education Centre.

Separate classes are held for males & females. Four classes (two in the morning & two in

the evening) are held working days. Two female yoga instructors are involved in teaching yogasanas to students and employees.

**ii) Yoga Certificate Course:-**

Part time Certificate Course in yoga of 3 months duration was started from August, 2003 in collaboration with Shriman Madhava Yoga Samiti Kaivalyadhama, Lonavla.

One Certificate Course in Yoga was conducted as follows:

1<sup>st</sup> August, 2018 to 30<sup>th</sup> November 2018, 49 students Participated.

**iii) Hepatitis B Vaccination Program.:-**

The Hepatitis B Vaccination Programme started from the academic year 2004-05. Three dose are given at a nominal cost of Rs.100/-

**iv) World Mental Health Week:**

On the occasion of World Mental Health Week an exhibition and health talk was organized in October, 2018 in collaboration with Regional Mental Hospital, Yerwada, Pune. Around 2200 people visited the exhibition and 935 people received counseling.

**v) Counseling Centre for University staff and students.**

Counseling centre for the University staff, University Students and students from colleges has been started with effect from July, 2012. Dr. Geeta Bhat, Hon. Psychiatrist, Shri. Alok Deodhar, and Smt. Nirupama Dastane counselors are visiting this centre from Monday to Friday between 3.00 pm. to 4.30 pm. During the period of report, around 1296 people took advantage of the facility.

**Students Facilitation Centre:**

‘Students Facilitation Centre’ is a facility created on the main campus at Pune and two district sub-centres of the university that allows students to submit standardized information and documents with a single entry point to fulfil all documents-related requirements. The archived electronic information further facilitates the process by avoiding multiple data submissions.

- Students Facilitation Centre (SFC) facilitates hassle-free transactions with the university under one roof with the help of technology and streamlined processes.
- Through SFC, students can make payments and obtain various documents from the university.
- The University has two satellite facilitation centers at our Ahmednagar and Nashik sub-centre.

The main value proposition for having a single window facility for the university is to increase the efficiency through time and cost savings for all the stakeholders in their interactions with the university authorities for obtaining the relevant documents and permissions for a variety of purposes.

Equipped with state-of-the-art IT platforms and connectivity, the SFC delivers essential services to the students in a time bound manner with high efficiency. Important sections of the university are connected through well-developed policies and procedures to carry out this massive task with utmost accuracy and reliability.

Provision to make online applications and payments along with door-delivery of the documents ensures student-friendly delivery of essential services.

**Jayakar Knowledge Resource Centre**

The Jayakar Library was recently named as Jayakar Knowledge Resource Centre (as Per the Universities Act 2016). It is the central library of the Savitribai Phule Pune University. The library

has a legacy of 69 years of functioning successfully and as an independent building, on its own, in approximately 1,50,000 sq. ft. Area. The activities recounted in this report demonstrate the commitment of Library staff to contributing to the fulfillment of Savitribai Phule Pune University's academic mission. The 2018–2019 Annual Report provides just a glimpse into the work of our dedicated Library staff carried out throughout the year.

#### **Knowledge Resource Committee:**

The Knowledge Resource Committee (consisting 8 members) is the apex body. It is the apex body of the Library System that frames the policies and procedures for the smooth functioning of the Library. The Knowledge Resource Committee met once during the year of the report. The Chairman and the members of the Knowledge Resource Committee made several suggestions in providing better services to the users of the Jayakar Library.

#### **Budget Provisions:**

The total budget for the year April 2018-March 2019 of the Jayakar Knowledge Centre was Rs.9,58,50,000/- out of which an amount of Rs. Six Crore was provided for the subscription of periodicals and online databases, and Rs.1.9 Crore for purchase of books and e-books. The funds provided to the Knowledge Resource Centre have been fully utilized. The insurance of the collection, equipment and Library Building has been continued.

#### **Acquisitions of Reading Material:**

The library has made available sufficient funds to all teaching departments which were approved by the Knowledge Resource Committee. Many scholarly print and electronic books were acquired during the period of report as per the recommendations of the heads of the departments and teachers.

### **Reference Service:**

Reference Service is the remarkable feature of any library. During the year of the report Knowledge Resource Centre has provided references in person, on telephone and through email. The Jayakar Knowledge Resource Centre also extends the facility of referring to the library to those who are not regular members of the library. Various participants of the variety of courses conducted their study tours and visited the library. For the new entrants of the university i.e. MA or M.Sc students, orientation programmes were conducted. In addition to this, the assistance was provided to use OPAC, to use card catalogue and locating the reading material.

### **Reading and Research Facilities:**

Jayakar Knowledge Resource Centre has a separate building for studying. Presently four reading halls having a capacity of 160 readers each are used by students. Reading and research facilities including bibliographical aids were extended to the Heads of the Departments, University Teachers, Post-graduate students, research scholars and research workers from sister universities and institutions. Specialized reading atmosphere is provided to the research students on a selective basis. Assistance has been provided in using the online journals, open source documents, document delivery service, documentation service and other library services. Under Document Delivery Service, the Knowledge Resource Centre receives articles from other Universities. On the other hand, the Knowledge Resource Centre has sent 37 articles on request to the users who required them.

The Study type Reading Hall was kept open on all the days of the week (including Sundays and holidays) between 7.00a.m. - 12.00p.m.

### **Jayakar Knowledge Resource Centre Portal:**

The main objective behind the development of the Knowledge Resource Centre portal was to provide one window access to library resources as well as free resources to all users on campus. To achieve this objective, the Knowledge Resource Centre has developed E- Resources Portal that contains information regarding online union catalogues of books, theses and serial publications. Web links are provided to various National Libraries, Open Access Resources of a variety of subjects and databases. The said portal is accessible through Internet and it is very useful to the students, staff, researchers and general public and libraries of the affiliated colleges of the University. After entering into MoU on 26<sup>th</sup> April 2011, till date more than 11466 theses of our university have been digitized and uploaded on this site. This year 585 theses were uploaded. The Knowledge Resource Centre is also uploading the latest degree awarded theses of the university.

### **UGC Study Centre:**

The UGC Study Centre is under the control of the Jayakar Knowledge Resource Centre. The centre provides reading facilities to undergraduate students from affiliated colleges and recognized institutions. The reading hall was kept open from 8.00 a.m. to 11.45 p.m. throughout the year.

## Chapter 6
