Rationale

The purpose of this programme is to analyze a topic that represents a concrete illustration of what / how philosophy, politics, and economics are interconnected on a practical level. Partnerships between industry and nongovernmental organizations (NGOs) seeking to promote sustainable development draw on themes derived from all three disciplines. They challenge how we traditionally think about the role of services in society and toward its stakeholders; they change how the for-profit and non-profit sectors conceive of each other and how they interact with one and other; and they influence how we analyze the idea of nation developmental aid and the effectiveness of policy- making strategies.

Corporate-NGO partnerships can be formed and implemented in different ways. It is difficult to evaluate the number of partnerships currently in existence, because many are formed between small local services and community groups and are not publicized. Additionally, partnerships can often involve other actors beyond NGOs and corporations such as local or national governments, international development institutions, or privately funded non-profit entities (such a philanthropic foundations), which makes them more complex to analyze. In this programme we focus on partnerships that attempt to promote development in a sustainable and ethical manner, for the stakeholders in developing countries of large corporations that carry out service internationally.

In this connection, Department of Adult, Continuing Education and Extension, University of Pune is organizing a Collaboration Programme on Role of University, Industry and NGO as partners of Sustainable Community Development on 23rd October, 2013 at the department.

Objectives

The main objectives of the collaboration programme would be to:

- i. Strengthen the relationship between industry and NGO through university
- ii. Prepare a calendar of activities for sustainable community developmental programmes and
- iii. How CSR / NGO can work together, illustrated by developing necessary skills and awareness to adopt the techniques as a sustainable alternatives for programme implementation through university.

Participants

About 50 representatives from industry and NGOs of University of Pune jurisdiction i.e. Pune, Ahmednagar and Nasik districts shall attend this programme. Other than these districts are not allowed for this special programme.
