In Indian Context

with special reference to Maharashtra, defining the Research Priorities is the way to help the researchers for designing and building the common future of our society.

While the role of higher education institutions in promoting Learning, Research and Extension has become unequivocally clear. Even maximum teachers have much more focused on teaching than research and extension. Our students in social sciences are also not much more oriented for research and development. Somewhere due to this fact, replications, and ambiguous problems to be occurred in research practices at students’ level. Maximum rural students are enrolled in faculty of Mental Moral and Social Sciences, with little formal understanding and lack of proper resources available to them, these students are facing the problems in developing the significant research questions in their project for Ph.D. and M. Phil. Degrees.

The need of the hour is to collectively use all the resources that the departments in the faculty of Mental,

Moral and Social Sciences have and share insights such that the academic arm of research and development is strengthened. This exercise will lead to a positive impact upon the larger developmental goals that India envisages for itself.
