

M.Sc. (Chemistry) 2015 Admission:

General Instructions and information about counselling and admission procedure:

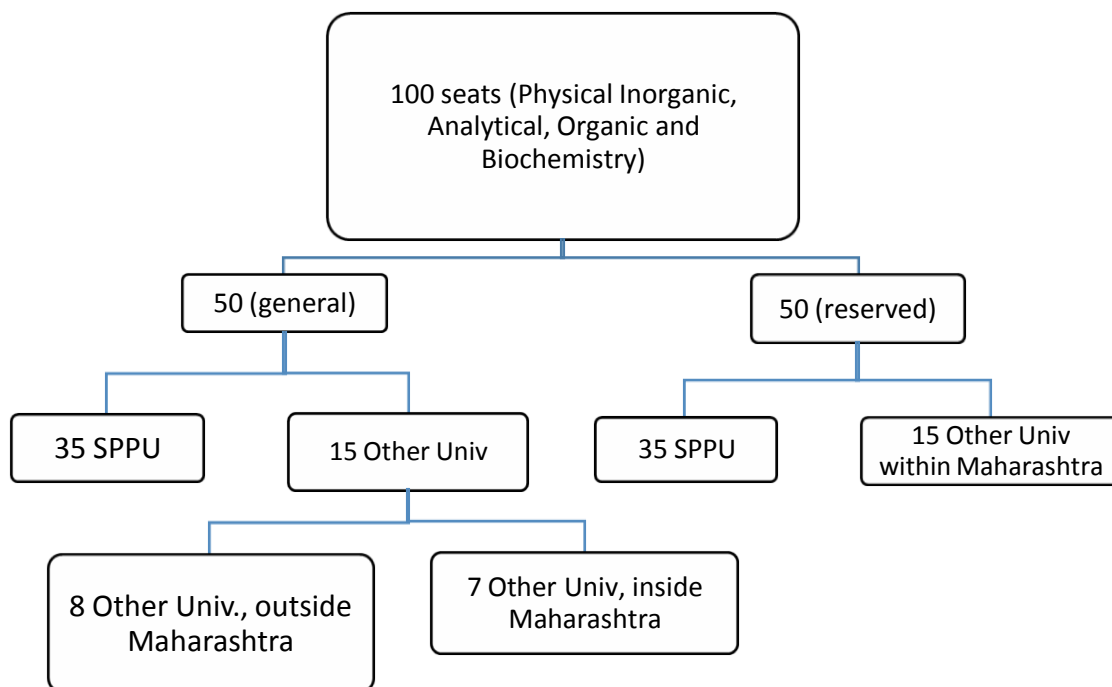
- **The admission for the M.Sc. Chemistry will be strictly via. University rules and regulations (Ordinance 181-A of SPPU).** To secure the admission, the candidate must be present for the counselling in-person with the original relevant documents. If for some reasons he/she can't attend the same then he/she must send his representative (a blood relative) with authorization letter and original documents. Your representative must be competent enough to take the decision on your behalf.
- On the day of counselling, the constituted committee members (faculty) and the Vice Chancellor's nominee will be present on the Dias. The process will be completely transparent. All the available seats based on the merit and University's social reservation policies (refer Ordinance 181-A of SPPU) and in consultation of admission committee will be displayed in advance.
- **The process of admission will be in a following order**
 - Name of the candidate will be called up in descending merit order.
 - His/Her original documents will be verified.
 - Based on the availability and choice, a seat will be offered and the letter of the provisional admission will be issued.
 - Student has to deposit his original B.Sc. final year mark-sheet and pay the fees to secure the admission.
 - Payment of the fees is in cash through Bank of Maharashtra Challan.
 - Hostel form, if applicable will be given to the student.
 - The students are expected to pay the fees immediately and deposit the copy of the challan to the chemistry office. This will confirm the provisional admission.
 - Any conflict of interest that might arise during the counselling will be solved by the admission committee.
- Limited hostel seats are available for the students from outside Pune. These will be filled again according to merit, social reservation and the availability. The hostels are tentatively available after 15 days of the admission. (So be prepared to accommodate yourself by your own, initially).

- **Following original Documents must be carried on the day of Counselling:**
 - B.Sc. grade card/mark-sheet, and passing certificate.
 - X and XII mark-sheets or domicile certificate as a proof of domicile.
 - Caste and cast validity certificate.
 - Recent Non-creamy layer certificate, if applicable.
 - Relevant proof/letter for the defence quota, Sport quota, Kashmir migrant quota and physically handicapped quota, if applicable.
- As of now, total 100 seats are available for the courses viz. Physical, Inorganic, Analytical, organic and biochemistry. Total 30 seats are available for Medicinal chemistry. Out of these 5 seats are filled by industry sponsored students. Candidates are encouraged to go through the fee structure for this course.
- The course will commence tentatively from Wednesday, 15th July 2015 morning 9:00 am, in PC Ray Hall. The attendance of all the provisionally admitted students is compulsory. The students absent for first 3 consecutive days will be assumed uninterested and his/her admission will be deemed cancelled. These seats will be offered to wait-listed candidate, as per the merit.
- All the students present on the day of counselling but not secured admission are entitled to contest for the wait list. The information of such candidates will be collected in the prescribed form on the day of counselling.
- First wait list will be displayed on the chemistry website tentatively within 8-10 days from the day of counselling. Students will be given three days time to secure their admission by paying the fees and submitting original documents. There will be no second wait list thereafter.

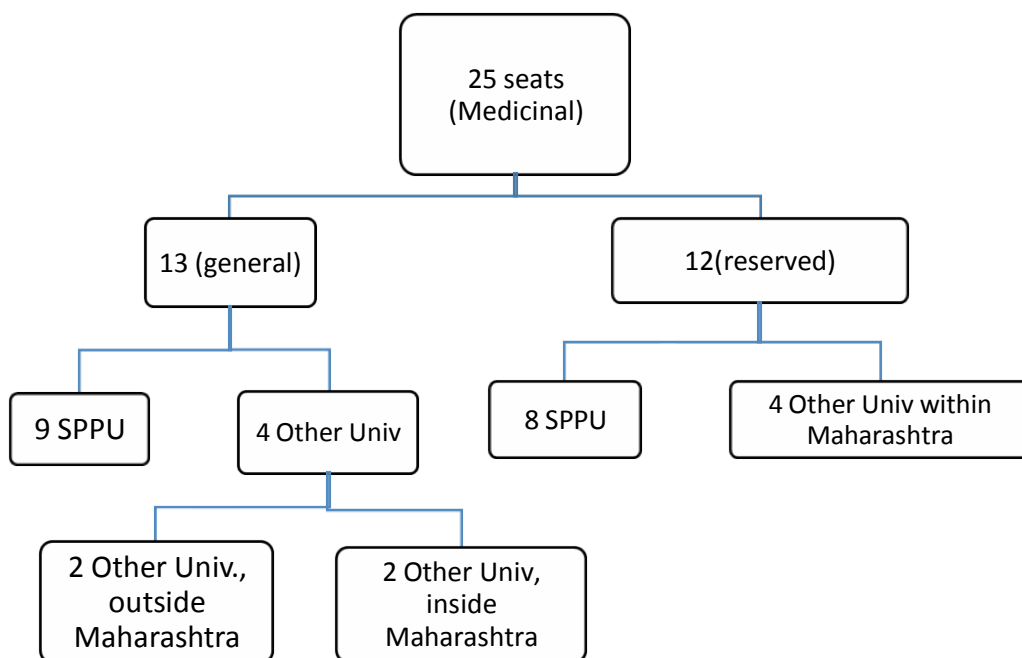

As per Ordinance 181-A of SPPU, the tentative distribution of the 100 seats:



Medicinal Chemistry: Total 30 seats are available. Out of which 5 will be filled by industry sponsored students. Distribution of 25 seats is as follows.



Over and above the total admitted students, 3% quote will allotted to physical handicapped, upto 5% for Kashmiri migrant, 5% Defence quota, and 3% sports quota. To claim defence quota, the students are requested to bring the documents in the prescribed format (refer attached PDF document).
