### 1) Debate Competition

#### Rules and Regulations

- Open only for undergraduate and post graduate students registered with colleges and university departments. Students should carry their valid college/institution identity card at the time of the competition
- Multiple entries from the same college/department/ institution are allowed.
- Topics announced are for the elimination round. Topics for the final round will be declared on the day of elimination round.
- Participants can speak in Marathi or English.
- Each participant will get Eight (6+2) min. to speak.
- Details of rules and debate procedures will be provided upon registration.
- Decision by the juries will be final and binding on the participants.

### **Rules and Regulations**

- Open only for undergraduate and post graduate students registered with colleges and University departments.
- The participants must submit a scanned photocopy of the college ID card during registration for the process.
- The photographs must represent or be based on one of the following themes: Power, Hope & Surprise. One participant can send only one photograph entry and only on one theme.
- All photograph submissions must be 20 megabytes or less in size
- All photograph submissions must be in JPEG or JPG format, and must be at least 1600 pixels wide (If a horizontal image) or 1600 pixels tall(if a vertical image)
- Any changes to the original photograph other than simple cropping, brightness and contrast matching are unacceptable and will render the photograph ineligible for a prize.
