COMMESSAY Competition 2013-14

The **D.S. Savakar** Chair has been instituted in 1989 in the memory of Late D.S. Savakar, India's alternative director in **International Monetary Fund** during 70s. He was also instrumental in shaping Commerce and Financial education system in US. This essay competition is organized as a tribute to him. The details of the Competition are as under:

- (1) The essay written in English or Marathi, shall not extend more than 10 full scap paper or 3000 lines.
- (2) Three prizes (Cash plus citation) will be awarded for each of the twogroups A, B, in each language
- (3) The entry for essay competition be accompanied with a forwarding letter cum certificate from the head of the College endorsing the affiliation of the writer as a student/faculty
- (4) The decision of the Board of Judges shall be final. The criteria for evaluation shall be originality, logical analysis, applicability and academic treatment. The right to cancel the entry or award of prize or declaration of result is reserved
- (5) The prize winning essays shall become the property of the Chair duly associated with author's copy right
- (6) The last date of receiving entries in the office of the D.S. Chair, C/O Department of Commerce & Research Centre, University of Pune, **Pune-7** shall be 31-10-2013 (5.00 pm)
- (7) The topics for COMMESSAY Competition, 2013-14 are as follows:

GROUP: A - (Regular UG or PG students of the colleges affiliated to the University of Pune)

Topic: Impact of financial education and business literacy on personality development

GROUP: B - (Faculty of the affiliated Colleges/University Departments, University of Pune)

Topic:Financial reforms in India: growth stimulant or inequality propellant
