

You are requested to send the duly filled Nomination cum Registration form to our correspondence address at the earliest to avoid last minute inconvenience to the students.

The college may grant the cost of registration to the nominated students (the registration fee for each nominated student leader is Rs. 1000/-). The participating student leaders will be provided snacks on January 10, lunch, tea and snacks on January 11 & 12, 2014 at the venue (MAEER's MIT Kothrud, Pune). A Participation Kit shall be handed over to the students at the time of reporting. This kit will contain identity card, badge, note-pad, pen, bag, T-shirt, motivational books and inspirational Video CDs. However, the participating students will have to make their own boarding and lodging arrangements at Pune. A certificate of participation will be issued to all participants after successful participation.



The Bharatiya Chhatra Sansad (Indian Student Parliament) is an appropriate platform for Student Leaders to express their views and exhibit their leadership quality. It is a good opportunity for those student participants who want to speak on the dais of Chhatra Sansad.

To participate in the selection process of the Student Speakers for the 5th BCS to be held from 10th to 12th Jan, 2015 at MIT Campus, Pune the students need to register for the national conclave as a participant and along with the registration form they need to send a recorded speech in a DVD format (audio-video) of maximum 5 minutes duration

in English or Hindi language only, on any of the 8 topics finalized for the 5th BCS as mentioned in the folder. Only the shortlisted student speakers will be called to MIT Pune for the final selection. 4 speakers (2 boys & 2 girls) per session will be given opportunity to speak.

The student speakers who will get the opportunity to speak from the dais during the 5th BCS will get a chance to go on an International Study Tour to Europe and also on a National Study Tour to Delhi on subsidized cost, organized by the MAEER's MIT School of Government, Pune.
