Training on "Police Mitra" in Pune Ganesh Festival - 2012

The Department of NSS of University of Pune and Police Commissioner of Pune jointly give appropriate training on the above topic to NSS volunteers during 9 to 14th Sept. 2012. During this camp 5000 volunteers received training of "Friends of Police" from the police trainers. This program is mainly focused on maintaining law and order, especially during the world famous Lord Ganesh Festival of Pune and also during the normal and crisis periods. Training was given to 5000 students (daily 500 students) about : disaster management, identifying dangerous articles, ownerless articles, suspect persons, precaution to be taken at the time of disasters, control on crowd at the time of Ganesh festival, benefits of Nirmalya-dan from environmental point of view, precaution to be taken at the time of fire or if the bomb is located or while getting control on the same. NSS volunteers help the traffic police to control the traffic at various important localities in Pune City. This important program was carried out by the NSS, University of Pune from social point of view.

Road Safety Campaign

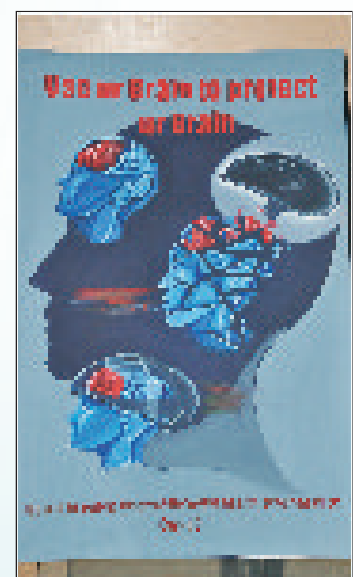
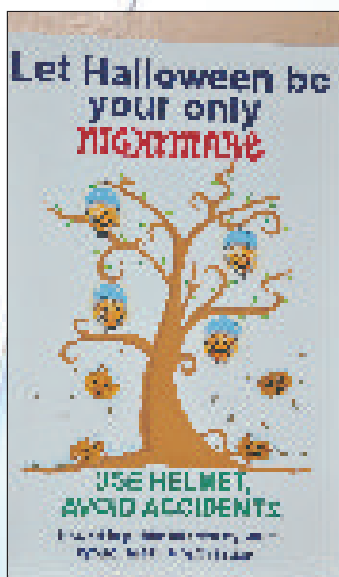
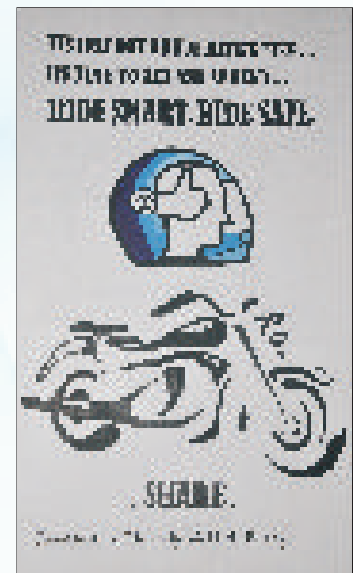

Distribution of Fodder for Drought affected animals in Purandar Taluka

Against the background of drought, fodder was distributed by N S S Pune University at the camps in the rural areas on 2 September 2012, Shri Chhatrapati Market Yard is a big market place of vegetables, fruits, flowers, grains in the whole vicinity and of their auction and distribution. One hundred volunteers and Program Officers from 11 N S S college units went to every section and collected vegetables and fodder. Some volunteers spontaneously gave donation, bought animal food, added 7 tons of various animal food to it, collected 200 kg oilcake, directly visited the camps in the areas of Guluchi, Pisurdi and Doundaj and distributed this material there free of charge.

So also they visited the livestock camp at Guluchi [Thopate Vasti] and distributed green fodder, vegetables and animal food there free of charge. The families in the drought-hit areas in Purandar Taluka have left their livestock in this camp. It is run with the help of Hon Sandip Kaka Jagtap. More than 2000 animals are gathered in this camp within the last three months. The family members also are staying with these animals. Their emotions were moving. Dr. Shakera Inamdar, N S S Program Coordinator, along with the N S S teachers and 100 volunteers participated in this program.
