He was appointed as a Visiting Research Fellow by New South Wales University, Sydney, Australia and awarded UGC Fellowship to visit France. In 2019, he was conferred the Best Academician (Law) Award by the Indian National Bar Association, New Delhi. Constitution Day also known as 'Samvidhan Diwas', is celebrated in our country on 26th November every year to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India. The Constituent Assembly, the body meant to draft the Constitution of India, held its first session on December 9, 1946. The assembly took over three years to draft the constitution. The last session of the Constituent Assembly ended on November 26, 1949. On 26th November 1949, the Constituent Assembly of India adopted the Constitution of India, which came into effect from 26th January 1950. In 2015, the Government of India decided to celebrate **26th day of November** every year as 'Constitution Day' to promote Constitutional values amongst citizens. 'To express gratitude to the makers of the Constitution and to reiterate the commitment of building India of their dreams', the Department of Law, Savitribai Phule Pune University celebrates Constitution Day every year.
