### Position 1 & 2: Junior Research Fellow

Period : 2 years

Salary : Rs. 9,000/-pm fixed

Qualifications :

**JRF 1 :** Master of Public Health or MSc Health Sciences with minimum 55% marks. The research will aim at describing the epidemiology of tuberculosis in a defined peri-urban field area covering 87,000 population.

**JRF 2 :** MSc Health Sciences or MSc in microbiology / life sciences with minimum 55% marks. Selected JRF will be involved in molecular epidemiology, specifically genotyping isolated Mtb strains.

### Position 3 : Data collector


Period : one year


Salary : Rs. 7,500/-pm fixed

Qualifications : MSc Health Sciences/ Master of Public Health with minimum 55% marks. Selected candidate will be expected to work on any defined component of epidemiological research either in the field or in the laboratory.
