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Support for Admission Process

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1. Preface

Savitribai Phule Pune University has been awarded 'Category-I' status by the University Grants Commission and the University has achieved 'Graded Autonomy'. As per the new National Education Policy, to increase the gross enrolment ratio in Higher Education, Savitribai Phule Pune University is also providing higher education through 'distance learning' mode along with regular mode.

Various courses have been made available through distance learning through the Centre for Distance and Online Education' of the university. Distance Education system has made Higher education accessible to the people who cannot opt for regular college education (especially the working class, housewives, senior citizens, citizens of remote areas, professionals, etc.).

Also, UGC has granted permission to pursue 2 degree programmes simultaneously. Accordingly, the regular college students have also the opportunity to pursue an additional degree through Distance Learning mode.

2. Distance Education System

The Distance education system facilitates to access the higher education to the students, who cannot attend college regularly. The University Grants Commission (UGC), New Delhi has declared that the degree obtained through 'Distance Learning' mode is equivalent to the degree obtained through the regular colleges.

To take admission in Distance Education system, a student must fill out an online admission and examination form, select a Study Centre, and submit the examination form at that Selected Study Centre. The Self-Learning material (books) written according to the syllabus are provided to the students after the completion of admission process. The internal assessment of students is completed at the respective Study Centre, whereas the End-Semester examination is conducted either at the respective Study Centre or at any other college.

3. Courses and Subjects offered

B.A., B.Com., M.A., M.Com. and M.B.A. programmes are offered through Distance Learning mode. The subjects available for these programmes are as follows:

1. B.A. (Bachelor of Arts):

Special Level – Marathi / English / Hindi / Sanskrit / History / Economics / Political Science / Public Administration / Sociology

General Level – Marathi / English / Hindi / Sanskrit / History / Economics / Political Science / Public Administration / Sociology / Geography / Education

2. B.A. Mathematics (Bachelor of Arts in Mathematics):

Mathematics is available at Special Level and General Level.

3. B.Com. (Bachelor of Commerce):

Special Level – Business Administration / Banking and Finance / Business Law & Practices / Cost and Works Accounting / Business Entrepreneurship / Marketing Management / Insurance, Transport and Tourism

4. M.A. (Master of Arts):

The Subjects available in M.A. programme are Marathi, Hindi, Sanskrit, English, History, Economics, Political Science, Sociology, Philosophy and Education. The medium of Learning for Sanskrit is Marathi, whereas the medium of learning for the subjects History, Economics, Political Science, Sociology, Philosophy and Education is both Marathi and English.

4. M.Com. (Master of Commerce):

Special Level – Advanced Accounting & Taxation / Commercial Laws & Practices / Advanced Cost Accounting & Cost system / Co-operation & Rural Development / Business Practices & Environment / Business Administration / Advanced Banking & Finance / Advanced Marketing

5. M.B.A. (Master of Business Administration):

Major & Minor Specialization: Human Resource Management / Marketing Management / Financial Management / Entrepreneurship Management / Project Management / International Business Management / Operation & Supply Chain Management / Business Analytics

Only Minor Specialization: Pharma & Healthcare Management / Tourism and Hospitality Management / Digital Marketing / Banking Management

4. Admission Eligibility

Eligibility for admission to B.A. / B.Com. is as follows:

- 1) Higher Secondary School Certificate (10+2) or its equivalent Examination with English.
- 2) Three Years Diploma Course after S.S.C. (10th standard) of Board of Technical Education conducted by Government of Maharashtra or its equivalent.
- 3) Diploma in Education of Bureau of Government of Maharashtra with English.
- 4) Industrial Training (I.T.I.) Certificate of minimum 2 Years Duration after S.S.C. (10th standard)

Eligibility for admission to M.A. / M.Com. is as follows:

Bachelor Degree of minimum 3 years duration from any recognized University

Eligibility for admission to M.B.A. is as follows:

- i. Bachelor Degree of minimum 3 years duration from any recognized University
- ii. Completed any degree with minimum 50 % (45 % for PWD candidates and candidates in reserved category from Maharashtra State only)

Note: Only Indian citizens are allowed to take admission through Distance Learning mode. There is no age limit for admission through Distance Learning mode. The number of seats for M.B.A. is 360 and for other programmes, there is no upper limit for number of seats. For M.B.A. programme, seats are allotted on the basis of marks through Entrance Examination as per the rules. The remaining seats, if any shall be filled on the first-come first-serve basis.

5. Admission Fee

The Fee for First Year of B.A./B.Com. is Rs. 7850/- for the students of Educational Boards from Maharashtra and Rs. 8670/- for the students of Educational Boards outside Maharashtra. The Fee for First Year of M.A. is Rs. 8300/- for the students of Universities in Maharashtra and Rs. 9120/- for the students of Universities outside Maharashtra. The Fee for First Year of M.Com. is Rs. 8950/- for the students of Universities in Maharashtra and Rs. 9800/- for the students of Universities outside Maharashtra. The Fee for First Semester of M.B.A. is Rs. 18,805/- for the students of Universities in Maharashtra and Rs. 20,605/- for the students of Universities outside Maharashtra.

This fee needs to be submitted online during the admission process. As this Fee includes registration fee, tuition fee, eligibility fee, study material fee, study centre fee and regular examination fee, no other fee or separate form for regular examination is required to be paid after paying the online admission fee.

6. Admission Process

6.1) Online Admission Process:

The website <https://unipune.ac.in/cdoe/admissionjuly2026.html> has been made available for the admission process. The steps in the admission process are as follows:

1) APAR-ID (ABC-ID):

APAR-ID (ABC-ID) needs to be obtained from ABC portal, the link of which is given on admission portal. It can be obtained through DigiLocker mobile app also. However, if it has been obtained previously, it can be used (& no need to obtain it again).

2) DEB-ID:

Further, DEB-ID needs to be obtained from DEB portal, the link of which is given on admission portal. However, if it has been obtained previously, it can be used (& no need to obtain it again).

3) Registration:

The link for registration has been provided on the admission process website. By filling in the required details on this link, the candidate needs to select the name of the programme to register. After that, enter your own email ID and mobile number. Click on the Verify button, enter the OTP received on your mobile and email ID, click on Create Account, and create a password. Students who have previously taken admission at the Centre for Distance and Online Education (formerly the School of Open and Distance Learning) are also required to re-register if they again want to take admission for the first year.

Since messages are sent by the University and the Study Centre to the mobile number and email ID provided by the student, the student must use their own mobile number and email ID while doing online registration.

The validity period of registration will be 6 years for B.A. / B.Com students and 4 years for M.A., M.Com. and M.B.A. students. If the course is not completed within this period (if all subjects are not passed), it will be mandatory for the student to re-register and take fresh admission in the first year to complete the course.

- Do not create new account if you have created account in previous session.
- Only one account per student is allowed.

4) Admission Form

After completing the registration, click on **Student:** [Log In](#) on the same webpage to fill out the admission form, or click on the admission form link provided on the admission process website. Log in by entering your mobile number or email ID and password followed by filling out the admission form online. If you forget your password, click on [Forgot Password](#) to reset the password. After logging in, fill out the application as follows:

- Click on New Course Enrollment.
- Select New under Student Type, and choose the Program Type, Program Name, and Medium.
- Select the specialization subject for M.A. programme. (The special subject selected for M.A. cannot be changed later. If candidate wants to change the subject, s/he must cancel the admission and fill out a new admission form within the admission process deadline.)
- Select the district from (Pune / Ahilyanagar / Nashik) where candidate want to take admission, and then select the name of the specific Study Centre for admission. (While taking admission through the distance learning mode, students have to select one Study Centre. The university has made "distance education" Study Centres available in various colleges across Pune, Ahilyanagar, and Nashik districts. A list of Study Centres is available in the online admission form. While filling out the admission form, students can choose any Study Centre of their convenience from the list.)
- Fill in the details of the 10th standard / Secondary School Certificate (SSC) or equivalent examination passed.
- Fill in the details of the 12th standard / Higher Secondary Examination / Diploma / Certificate (ITI) or equivalent examination passed.
- If you have previously passed a Bachelor degree examination, fill in those details. (If you have obtained more than one Bachelor degrees previously, fill in the details of any one degree, provided that degree is of minimum 3 years duration.)

- Then click on the Save button.
- Further, enter the DEB-ID and click on Save & Next.
- Then upload your photo and signature. (No other documents need to be scanned and uploaded while filling out the online admission form.)
- Next, fill out the examination form. Carefully select the subjects in the form.
- Proceed to pay the admission fee online. (While paying the online admission fee, if the money has been deducted from your bank account (transaction successful) and the admission payment receipt (PDF) is not downloading, do not pay the fee again (do not make a double payment). Wait for 48 hours after payment and then download payment receipt. If not done, send the following details to the email ID student.sol@unipune.ac.in: Bank name, transaction ID, and payment method - Card / UPI / Net Banking)
- After paying the admission fee, click on Exam Form Print and Admission Payment Receipt to download the examination form and admission payment receipt. Since it will not be possible to download these files after the admission process, both PDF files should be downloaded and safely stored along with their printed copies until the completion of the course.

6.2) Admission Process at Study Centre:

After the admission payment, the student has to submit the printed copy of the downloaded admission payment receipt and examination form along with the required documents at the study centre selected till 05:00 on 31st August 2026. Admission will be confirmed only after submitting the examination form along with the required documents at the Study Centre. So, the admission form must be submitted at the Study Centre before the due date. If the examination form is not submitted to the Study Centre before the due date, the admission form will be cancelled and the admission will not be confirmed.

7. Documents required for Admission

There is no need to scan and upload any documents while filling the online admission form. However, after completing the online admission process, the following documents are required to be produced while submitting the admission form at the Study Centre:

- 1) Examination Form (2 Copies)
- 2) Admission Payment Receipt (Submit the College/Study Centre copy to Study Centre and take stamp of Study Centre on Student copy and preserve carefully)
- 3) Aadhar Card (Produce Original & submit Xerox Copy)
- 4) S.S.C. (10th Standard) Certificate (Produce Original & submit Xerox Copy)
- 5) Marksheet of Qualifying Examination (Produce Original & submit Xerox Copy)
(Note: Marksheet of 12th Standard / Diploma / ITI Certificate / Equivalent examination for admission to B.A./B.Com. programme and marksheet of Bachelor degree for admission to M.A./M.Com./M.B.A. programme)
- 6) Proof of Change in Students' name, if any (Produce Original & submit Xerox Copy)
- 7) One of the following (as applicable)

Leaving / Transfer / Migration / Bonafide Certificate (Original)

or Marksheet (Xerox Copy) for old students of CDOE (SODL)

i) **Leaving Certificate** is required in case the previous admission is as a regular student in Junior College affiliated to Maharashtra State Board of Secondary & Higher Secondary Education.

ii) **Transfer Certificate** is required in case the previous admission is

- a) in the college affiliated to Savitribai Phule Pune University or
- b) as a regular student in any Department of Savitribai Phule Pune University or
- c) as an external student of Savitribai Phule Pune University

Transfer Certificate is not required if the previous admission is in Centre for Distance and Online Education (School of Open and Distance Learning) of Savitribai Phule Pune University.

- iii) **Migration Certificate** is required in case the previous admission is
- a) as an external(private) student of Maharashtra State Board of Secondary & Higher Secondary Education
 - or
 - b) in Educational board other than Maharashtra State Board of Secondary & Higher Secondary Education
 - or
 - c) in Department /College of any other University
- iv) If the student is presently admitted for UG / PG course at any other College / University, then the **Bonafide Certificate** from that College / University shall be necessary.
- v) If the previous admission is in Centre for Distance and Online Education (School of Open and Distance Learning) of Savitribai Phule Pune University, then Transfer Certificate is not required. Such students need to submit the Xerox Copy of previous marksheet of CDOE (SODL). (TC is not required in such cases even if the Study Centre is changed)
- If the candidate does not have the **Leaving / Transfer / Migration / Bonafide Certificate** while submitting the examination form at the study centre, an undertaking in the prescribed format must be submitted along with the examination form. The admission will be confirmed only after this certificate gets submitted to the Study Centre.
- Before submitting the examination form to the study centre, the student must carefully check the personal details (name, mobile number, e-mail ID, address etc.) mentioned on the examination form. If any correction is to be made in these details, the application in the prescribed format must be submitted to the Study Centre along with the examination form.

❖ All the students should note that the admission will not be confirmed if, the student fails to submit the examination form (printed copy) along with the necessary documents to the Study Centre before due date.

8. Important Instructions for the students

- After submitting the examination form and admission payment receipt at the Study Centre, obtain a stamp from the Study Centre on one copy and preserve it carefully until the completion of the entire programme.
- After the admission process gets completed, all students will be added to a Whatsapp / Telegram group by the Study Centre. Further notices regarding Permanent Registration Number (PRN), Syllabus, study material (books), internal assessment (assignments), end-semester examinations, etc. will be provided in this group from time to time. Students should ensure that they are added to the official Study Centre group and carefully check the notices provided in the group periodically.
- Students must regularly visit the website <https://unipune.ac.in/CDOE/> for updates and notices displayed time to time regarding the admission process, examinations, results, etc.

- Student can select any 1 subject from English Communication / Marathi Language / Hindi Language.
- In Group 'SEC1' and 'CC' student has to select 3 subjects from English / Sanskrit / Sociology / Marathi / Hindi / History / Economics / Political Science / Public Administration / Education / Geography. The student can select 3 subjects in this group from the subjects selected at F.Y.B.A. The subject that is to be selected at the special level must be selected within this group.
- The Group of 3 papers i.e. 'DSE1, DSE2, SEC2' is Special Level group. The subjects English / Marathi / Hindi / Sanskrit / History / Economics / Political Science / Public Administration / Sociology are available at special level. A subject at Special Level can be selected only if that subject is selected at F.Y.B.A. The subject 'English' can be selected at Special level only if the subject '115-Optional English' is selected at F.Y.B.A.
- The subject selected at Special Level should be selected in the Group 'SEC1' / 'CC' also.
- The Self-Learning Material (Books) and examination for Sanskrit subject is in Marathi medium only (English medium is not available).
